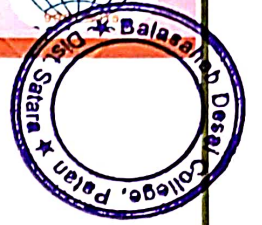

National Cadet Corps (NCC) !:

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the Indian Armed Forces' youth wing, with its headquarters in New Delhi, India ¹. The NCC is headed by the Director General (DG), a three-star officer, and is organized as follows :

- Directorate: There are 17 directorates in state capitals, each headed by a Maj Gen from the three Services.
- Division/Regimental Corps: There are three specialized corps in Mumbai, Delhi, and Bangalore, each headed by an equivalent of a Lt. General and reporting to the HQ.
- Group: Depending on the state's size and NCC growth, directorates have up to 14 group headquarters, each headed by an officer with the rank of brigadier or equivalent.
- Battalion: Each NCC Group Headquarters controls 5-7 units (Bns) commanded by a Colonel/Lt.Col or equivalent.
- Company: Each Battalion consists of companies, which are commanded by an Associate NCC Officer (ANO) ranked from lieutenant to major.

History:

- Formed in 1948 as a successor to the University Officers Training Corps (UOTC)
- First NCC Unit raised on November 28, 1948, by Jawaharlal Nehru
- Girls Division formed in 1949
- Air Wing added in 1950, Naval Wing in 1952

Motto and Aim:

- Motto: "Unity and Discipline"
- Aim: Develop leadership, officer-like qualities, and social service

Organization:

- Headquartered in New Delhi
- Led by Director General (DG) with two Additional DGs
- 17 Directorates, 96 Group Headquarters, and 837 units

Training:

- Total training period: 3 years for SD and SW, 2 years for JD and JW
- Annual training camps: National Combined Annual Training Camp (9-10 days) and Republic Day Camp (29 days)

Certificates and Examination:

- Three certificates: A, B, and C
- Grading system: A (80% and above), B (65-79%), C (50-64%), Fail (below 50%)
