Report

Shivaji University Kolhapur Sponsored One Day National Seminar on “Resource Planning and Management for Sustainable Development” concluded on Friday 15th March 2024 at Balasaheb Desai College, Patan. On the occasion of the inauguration of this seminar, Vice Chancellor of Shivaji University Prof. (Dr.) D. T. Shirke was. Shrimant Amarsingh Patankar, General Secretary of Koyna Education Society was in the chair. At the inauguration, the Vice-Chancellor explained the need and purpose of such national seminars in line with the new education policy. Such discussion sessions are needed to create an interdisciplinary approach for students as well as teachers to bring about discussion and brainstorming on various topics. As an example of explaining a parallelism in both language and culture as well as social science, he referred to Krishnat Khot's recently published novel 'Ringana' in which sustainable development is presented through language and culture. The Vice-Chancellor mentioned the progress of the college and congratulated all the faculty on the recent NAAC A+ grade of the college. He expressed his belief that various courses and new branches of the college should be made available to the students. Shrimant Amarsinh Patankar in his presidential address reviewed the material progress of the college in 50 years. Presented the efforts of Koyna Education Society to implement innovative activities continuously. Principal Dr. S. D. Pawar, gave introduction and welcome. IQAC Coordinator Dr. H. V. Kate thanked for the program. On this occasion, Koyna Education Society Director Srimant Yadnsen Patankar and Director Hon. Sanjeev Chavan and Joint Secretary Dr. Suhas Deshmukh also present.

“Resource Planning and Management for Sustainable Development” Professor of Geography Department as the key note speaker for Dr. Praveen Saptarshi. Guided that If sustainable development is actually to be achieved, the environment needs to be added. In the pursuit of development, human beings are ignoring the degradation of the environment. should also be considered. The use and loss suffered by future generations should also be considered. He expressed the opinion that while implementing projects like Samriddhi Highway, there was a large-scale loss of land, forest, trees and environment, the damage is not being compensated. If development is to be human-centered and sustainable and sustainable, everyone needs to realize responsibility and change through cooperation.

In the first session, Shivaji University Geography Department Head Prof. Dr. Suresh Pawar was resource person. He emphasized on three things in the context of sustainable development namely water, forest and land, and also explained the damage to the environment through a slide show, expressed the opinion that if the goal of sustainable development is to be achieved, everyone should work together to protect the environment.

Dr. Bhimashankar Birajdar also opined on how a sustainable environment should be developed from both natural resources and human resources.

At the conclusion, Shivaji University History Department Head Prof. Dr. Avnish Patil. He gave historical references for sustainable development. How sustainable development has been attempted since 6000 BC In the recent fifty years the rapid development cycle has not taken into account the environmental damage, degradation and loss caused by the inclusion of the entire world in the cycle.

He lamented that even though we have recently come out of an epidemic like COVID-19, humans are not wise enough to take steps towards sustainable development.



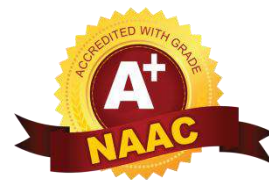
